

**Did You Know:**

- Typical residents spend 7% of their income on heating fuel in the winter;
- Walk For Warmth recipients spend over 30% of their budget to heat their homes;
- More than 62% of those who seek HDC help with fuel payments receive no public assistance, and 56% are employed or have become recently unemployed;
- A typical Walk for Warmth recipient is a two or three person household;
- 18% are disabled 60% have children in the household.
